It is important for everyone – old and young, to make a will and review it regularly. After making provision for your family, we hope that you will consider making provision for your church of St Andrew's.



## Our Legacy Policy

Many people give regularly to St Andrew's so that we can carry out God's mission and ministry in the parish. We are stewards of everything we own, and lasting gifts in wills are a natural part of Christian giving.



Since needs change over the years, we encourage gifts to be left for the general purposes of the church rather than for a specific purpose. We will then discuss the possible use of gifts with executors, bearing in mind the giver's known areas of interest in the church and the church's priorities at the time.

## Your Gift



Our promise is to use all gifts to further our mission to share the love of Christ. In this way, you can be confident that your gift will have a lasting effect, both now and for generations to come.

Suggested wording for your will:

"I give .....% of my residuary estate, OR I give the sum of £..... (pounds only) free of all taxes, to the Parochial Church Council of the Parish of St Andrew's, Oxshott (UK Registered Charity No 1128379) in the Diocese of Guildford, and I declare that the receipt of an officer of the Parochial Church Council shall be sufficient discharge to my executors and trustees."
