The PCC has recently considered and approved a new name, policy and approach for our links with Mission Partners locally, nationally & internationally. This will build upon the superb work done by Liz de Wet Stein, in particular, whilst leading us into a new season.

We are looking to focus attention and communication on a smaller number of partners with the goal that these foster deep relationships and engagement for the whole congregation. This will be encouraged through prayer, two way visits, mutual learning & support and financial commitment.

There will probably be, say 6, Main Mission Partners and 3 or 4 others in a subsidiary group.

As we do this, we seek your input, opinions and offers to participate, through this questionnaire. In particular we ask you to rank those you think should be included from 1 to 11 (1 being high and 11 low)

You may notice that two former partners are not included as they are no longer serving in those places and our links have ended:

- CMS Partners, the Waltons in Dar es Salaam, Tanzania
- Interserve Partners, the Hickeys in Nepal & India

- Inspire London, which is now an established Church
- Treasures in Heaven, as links with Max Sinclair have diminished
