General statement of policy

At St Andrew's Oxshott, we welcome all gifts in wills, large or small, and we promise to use these gifts in our mission to share the gospel of Jesus Christ and to make a difference to lives of people in our parish and beyond. Our Legacy Policy is to encourage all members of the church and others outside the church to consider including a gift to St Andrew's in their will.

Since needs change over the years, we encourage gifts to be left in wills for the general purposes of the church rather than for a restricted purpose. We will discuss possible uses of gifts with executors when the time comes bearing in mind the giver's known areas of interest in the church and the church's priorities at the time.

All gifts will be used in the furtherance of our mission to share the love of Christ with the people of Oxshott and around the world. In this way, we can be confident the legacies we receive will have a lasting effect for generations to come.

We acknowledge gifts in whatever way the donor and/or his/her executors feel most appropriate. Equally, we can make sure that gifts remain anonymous if the donor prefers.

This policy is approved and overseen by the PCC. Those authorised to speak to potential donors about a legacy include the Vicar and the Treasurer.

Organisation and responsibilities

1. The PCC is responsible for agreeing the policy.
2. The Parish Giving Committee, as 'custodian' of the policy, is also expected to bring the attention of the PCC to any necessary changes to it that may arise and to seek renewal of the policy on the due date.
