The big news for Tanka and his family is that his daughter Rhema came home for the first time in nearly three years, and they were all able to be together for Christmas! This picture shows (left to right) Rita, Nishma, Tanka, Charisma & Rhema.



The reason for this was a crisis in Rhema's health and well-being and she has needed a host of consultations over Christmas – all a lot cheaper than private medical care in Canada! **Tanka writes:** *'She is quite refreshed and physically strong again. She wanted to go back for study, so went back this Wednesday. Treatment for her spinal compression is not done now but later when she comes in May. Thank you for prayer and support. Please continue to pray for the financial pressure we face. Rhema also did not buy eyeglasses because it was too expensive. We bought them here and now Rhema says she did not realize before that she needed eyeglasses that badly! So many positive things. Praise the Lord for everything.'*

Also: At the end of November, Guy Harper was able to deliver small gifts from us to Tanka & Rina in person - in a restaurant in Kathmandu - as Guy was off to climb one of the Himalayas near Everest!

The 70 strong local Family of God Church, which Tanka leads, resumed meeting before Christmas and sent warm greetings to everyone.

Give thanks for the Lord's protection and provision for Rhema and pray for:

1. Rhema's continuing care and well-being back in Toronto.
2. The Family of God Church and its four other congregations, whose every meeting might be deemed illegal by the authorities!
3. The personal financial pressures that Tanka alludes to above.
