Tanka had been at an Increase Gathering in Turkey (with Qaiser) renewing relationship with the Committee and Increase Equippers as well as setting the direction for Increase and laying plans for the larger November 2022 Gathering we prayed for last week. This was his first time away from the many pressures of his role and responsibilities in 2 years, so he was glad to slow down a little. Rita is involved in the running of this, so it may be that we can assist them both in coming to visit us again in early December.
