## Update and prayer from Tanka Subedi, Nepal and ITeen

Tanka has recently returned from a mission trip to Bhojpur in the Eastern hills of Nepal. They (his church) have an orphanage there. He writes: "The flight was very scary as the weather was extremely bad. While in the air many people got sick on the plane but finally it landed safely."

Tanka then drove for 6 hours to reach the place Bhiopur. [These remote areas are often neglected by the government, but Christians have sought to bring relief and hope, helping them rebuild after natural disasters.] "The trip too was very fruitful. Ten people were baptised there - see the pictures. We were also able to help them with some food and clothes."
