We had some busy times at ITeen and some sickness as well: Suroj, his wife and Binaya, members of the team, caught covid again, but are now recovered. Rhema, our eldest daughter, was back with us in Nepal for three months. This was good, restoring relationships after most of the last 3 years apart, but she is already back in Halifax studying. This is financially challenging for us. We (Tanka, Rita & their team) have a Pastors' Conference in Chitwan, from 5 to 8 September. This is six hours' drive from us in Kathmandu. 200+ pastors working with us will come.
