Update and prayer requests from Tanka Subedi

Tanka wrote last month reporting that he, Rita & their team had a superb Pastors' Conference in Chitwan, in September. 150 pastors were able to join them for training and encouragement, including in the use of TEE. **Thank you for your prayers.**



Unfortunately, Tanka and Rita are unable to travel to North Cyprus for a conference they hoped would refresh them, because Tanka caught Dengue Fever at the end of September. This is a viral infection transmitted by mosquitoes, endemic in Nepal, where severe dengue is a leading cause of serious illness and death. Tanka went briefly to hospital, but was soon allowed home. A lingering weariness is common and 3 weeks later he is still very weak and unable to go to work.

Please pray for his recovery, because Rita and Tanka also plan to attend an Increase Association Gathering in Malaysia 26 Nov to 3 Dec 2022, *'Equipping the Saints in Asia & beyond'*.

Tanka is on the Increase Committee and a leading contributor to the successive gatherings for Equippers, Leaders and the Main Conference. Rita is also part of the planning team (as is Jolyon). **Pray for healing, energy, inspiration and wisdom for Tanka and Rita and for a fruitful conference.**

Please also pray for Tanka and Rita's daughter, Rhema, who is studying in Canada with a number of practical and health issues. These now include a possible brain tumour and the wait for an MRI is six months!
