Both seemed tired and heavy laden: they carry multiple leadership responsibilities, are very concerned for their daughter Rhema in Canada, and face mounting financial challenges with family education and medical costs. Rita has recently written, hoping we all had a great Christmas and describing theirs:

“We had a wonderful time. We celebrated Christmas on 24th at Kathmandu. We then travelled south for another Christmas celebration, to a place called Hetauda, reaching it after 4hrs drive. Roadbuilding was in progress so there were lots diversions. 25th was special as it was the inauguration of a new church building - Tanka was invited and I joined him. The government had given money to build this church and there were two distinguished political figures with Tanka for the inauguration.”
