22 October 2023 Mission Partner prayer and update - A Rocha

Andrew Samuel, Reserve Manager at Wolf Fields offers this update and pointers for prayer:

I have been able to recruit two new volunteers and have created a leaflet for Wolf Fields.

I am planning a door to door leaflet drop in November around the local area to spread the word about Wolf Fields and A Rocha UK to try and recruit more local volunteers. At the moment, I'm working with volunteers to clear out patches of bramble that aren't being used by wildlife and are restricting the amount of space available on-site. The main area I am focusing on is the bramble growing along the site's fence.



The plan is to convert that area into a grass and/or wildflower meadow and to add more food growing areas.

Personally, one of the biggest challenges I'm facing is time management and communication. These are issues that were brought up during my probation review and I'm trying to work on it more and manage my time effectively and keep proper communication with people.

Please pray that:

- I am able to recruit more, interested, volunteers from the local community
- I am able to find the right balance between nature and accessibility on site - I would like to keep the reserve wild but also have to keep it accessible
- I don't feel discouraged and I'm able to manage my time and find a good balance between work and non-working life
